QUALIFICATIONS

- 1. The Member at Large shall have a minimum of two years continuous sobriety.
- 2. The Member at Large shall be appointed by the Board of Directors to serve a one-year term, renewable for one additional term.
- 3. The Member at Large shall work with Central Office volunteers to ensure that a variety of information is provided to the AA community in an accurate and timely fashion.

TIME ESTIMATE

No specific work hours are required but it is estimated that the Member at Large will spend up to 6 hours per month on Central Office business. Attendance at Board and Intergroup meetings is 2 hours per month, and attendance at meetings is estimated to be 2 hours.

DUTIES

The Member at Large shall perform their duties in the best interest of the Central Office, keeping in mind the overall purpose and guidelines of Alcoholics Anonymous.

Specific duties include the following:

1. Attend monthly Board and Intergroup meetings.

2. Attend area AA meeting to introduce represent the Central Office

3. Distribute the Meeting Directories and Newcomer Packets at visited AA meetings.

4.Represent Central Office at District Convention Committee and arrange representation at Convention.
