Board Reports

Chairperson – Dick B

- Convention registration is open; encouraged everyone to register.
- Email distribution list to be updated to include Justin, Tom, and Katie so all reps receive the minutes.
- Noted he is past his term limit and welcomes a replacement for his board position in the future, but will continue serving for now.

GSR Report – Kathy R

- No report this month due to hit-and-miss meetings; will attend the GSR meeting today (Service Sunday) and report next month.

Secretary – Vanessa S

- Minutes from last meeting sent out.
- Motion to approve made, seconded (Brenda, Melissa, Kathy R), all in favor.

Treasurer – Melissa M

- Back in the black.
- **May:** Net revenue of \$341.22 for the month. Total revenue of \$2,861.26
- **Year-to-Date (Jan–May):** Net revenue of \$1,126.50 on total revenue of \$17,500.48
- **Balance Sheet (as of June 3):** Total assets of \$41,898.62, including bank balances of \$31,027.20 and inventory of \$10,760.74. Prudent reserve in good shape.
- Inventory is tracked as books are sold; the count stays roughly the same because new books are purchased as stock runs out, even as prices rise.
- Motion to approve made, seconded, all in favor.

Literature – Brad L

- Not present; given by Dick B.
- As of his last office visit, literature was up to date. Per the board meeting earlier this month, all back orders have been filled.

Communications – Open

- Open position.

Member at Large – Jim D

- Most meetings are running well with no serious issues.
- The Wednesday beach meeting in Cayucos needs a new secretary following the passing of its previous secretary.
- **Convention:** Planning meeting is today. Sign-ups are down compared to last year; encouraged all meetings to register at myd22.org.
- **Convention theme:** "A New Freedom and a New Happiness."
- Central Office will again have a table at the convention (set up for Saturday); Jim will organize and staff it.

Staff Reports

Volunteer Coordinator – Kathleen W

- Not present; given by Dick B.
- The volunteer pizza party planned for later this month was canceled due to insufficient interest.
- Volunteer calendar is mostly filled; still seeking weekday office-shift volunteers (12–3 PM or 3–6 PM).
- Phones are forwarded and covered 24/7.

COR Reports

Ben B, ABC Group (Paso Robles)

- Offering three meetings a day, seven days a week, plus occasional extra meetings.
- Finances breaking even; slightly over last month.
- Steering committee meets tomorrow.
- Ben has moved to Atascadero and will announce his COR position as open, hoping a regular attendee can take it over; he retains his secretary commitment at the group.

Brenda, Mesa Group (Arroyo Grande)

- A quarterly contribution to Central Office will be made this month.
- A member proposed moving the monthly speaker meeting (second Saturday) to a Friday due to low attendance and a conflict with the Orchid speaker meeting. The group decided instead to promote it more heavily (in the basket and on Facebook) before considering a move.
- Finances good; \$137 over prudent reserve.

Katie, Pioneer Group

- Filling in; not attending regularly, reporting from the group's minutes.
- Steering committee has several vacant positions: event chair, COR rep, and secretary.

- Founders Day: no event noted (Founders Day was June 10 and has passed).
- Prudent reserve down \$149.45.
- Will take this information back to the steering committee.

Sharon H, Saturday Morning Women's Meeting (Morro Bay) & Sense of Belonging (Los Osos, Thursday)

- The Thursday night meeting is working through a book on atheists, with good discussion on spirituality and strong attendance.
- The Saturday morning women's meeting remains full with steady, growing attendance and is running smoothly.

Tom, Sunday Evening Rap Group

- Hybrid group on Sunday nights at the Gala Center, SLO; attendance steady at roughly half Zoom, half in person, with no summer drop-off so far.
- Finances slightly in the black and steady.

Justin, Village Group

- Meetings running as normal with good attendance; the 7 AM meeting runs seven days a week and is often standing-room only.
- Group is discussing changes to its prudent reserve and its contributions.
- Business meetings are held quarterly.

Additional Notes

Literature pricing (raised during discussion): Groups may resell literature at any price they choose once purchased from Central Office, since they have already paid the applicable sales tax. The Big Book price is increasing to approximately \$14. Pamphlets are sold for 25 cents or given away (in newcomer packets, to groups, and to those in need), so no inventory is kept on them.
